

## Lodge House Surface Mine Community Fund

The successful applicants from the **first meeting (April 2013)** were:

- **St John the Baptist Church, Smalley** - £1,731 towards external improvements
- **Holy Trinity Church, Mapperley and Mapperley Parish Council** - £4,439 towards a replacement sound system
- **Mapperley Parish Council** - £6,000 towards an outdoor adult fitness / recreation base
- **Horsley Woodhouse Community Association** - £1,386 towards the July 2013 Horsley Woodhouse Carnival
- **Horsley Woodhouse Over 60's Club** - £250 towards the cost of a day trip on the River Trent

In the **second meeting (July 2013)** successful applicants were:

- **Shipleigh Parish Room Trust** - £890 for roof repairs
- **Smalley Richardson Endowed Primary School** - £22,998 towards Early Years Outdoor Learning Play Provision
- **Horsley Woodhouse Parish Council** - £15,000 towards replacement play equipment on the Sitwell Memorial Recreation Playground
- **Smalley Parish Council** - £85,150 for development of the Dobholes Lane Recreation Ground
- **Holy Trinity Church Mapperley and Mapperley Parish Council** - £3,222 for footpath improvements and £2,950 for the replacement of fascia and soffits at the Church

In the **Third meeting (October 2013)** successful applicants were:
