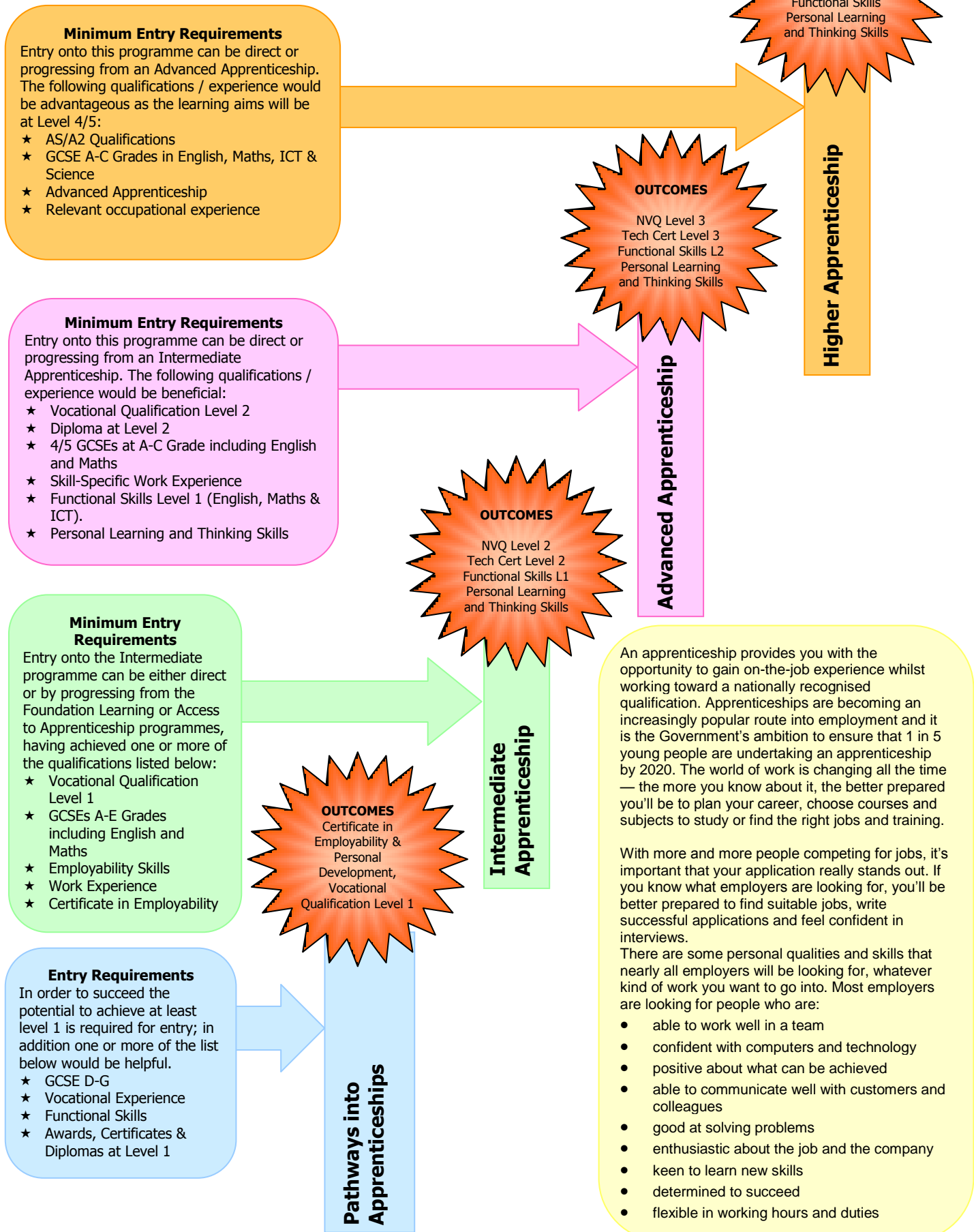

Progression Pathways into Apprenticeships

Derbyshire is a large & diverse area comprising several jobs markets and travel areas. The North is dominated by small to medium employers with the South having larger employers in the form of Toyota (car manufacturer), East Midlands Airport, Rolls Royce (aero engines), Bombardier (train makers) and Derby hospitals. Heavy manufacturing engineering accounts for 23% of jobs, call centres, employment Agencies and & local government employ some of the largest numbers of people.

Other growth sectors include health & social care, creative industries mainly in the Derby area including advertising, performing arts and interactive software. Significant construction is planned around Markham Vale, M1 Junction 29A, Derby City and the A61 corridor bringing jobs not only in construction but in retail, hospitality and business units. Expansion of East Midlands Airport in both its passenger and freight capacity will bring jobs in logistics, security, and hospitality and air staff.
