

DERBYSHIRE & DERBY MINERALS PLAN

Notice of a Drop-in Day To be held at Repton Village Hall Thursday 4th October from 11.00am to 7.00pm

Derbyshire County and Derby City Councils together are preparing a Minerals Plan for the area. This document will begin by setting out a broad vision and strategy for minerals development in Derby and Derbyshire to 2030, and provide the framework against which planning applications for mineral development will be judged. Importantly, it will also show sites from where minerals will be supplied.

A number of sites have been put forward by mineral operators for future sand and gravel extraction, two of which may potentially have an impact on this area (shown on the maps below). All sites put forward must now be assessed to determine whether they will be included in the plan.

Council officers will be at the Village Hall on Thursday 4th October from 11am to 7.00pm to explain the plan in more detail and to answer any questions. Your input will be vital to the development of this plan. Please drop in whenever you want between these times for a chat about the plan. We would be grateful if you could tell any of your neighbours about this event if they have not received this leaflet.
