

DERBY & DERBYSHIRE MINERALS PLAN

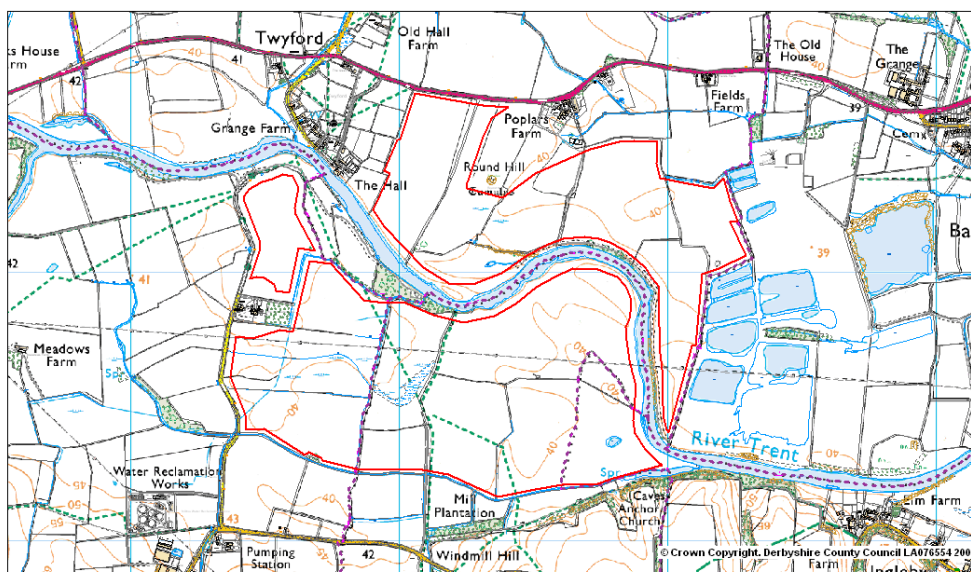
Notice of a Drop-in Day To be held at Barrow-on-Trent Village Hall Wednesday 26th September, 11.00 am to 7.30 pm

Derbyshire County Council and Derby City Council together are preparing a Minerals Plan for the area. This document will set out a broad vision and strategy for minerals development in Derby and Derbyshire to 2030, and provide the framework against which planning applications for mineral development will be judged. Importantly, it will also show sites from where minerals will be supplied.

A number of sites have been put forward by mineral operators for future sand and gravel extraction, one of which lies in this parish (shown edged red on the map below). All sites put forward must now be assessed to determine whether they will be included in the plan.

Council officers will be at the Village Hall on Wednesday 26 September from 11.00am to 7.30pm to explain the plan in more detail and to answer any questions about the Minerals Plan. Your input will be vital to the development of this Plan. Please drop in whenever you want between these times for a chat about the Plan.
