Organisation: Buxton Museum and Art Gallery (Derbyshire County Council)

Main activity –

The museum is currently developing 'Pocket Wonders' – mobile experience that connects museum collections the Peak District landscape. We need pioneering volunteers to test and evaluate the museum's digital and mobile content – helping to shape the direction of the experience.

Tasks might include:

- Attending pre-planned testing events
