

# Derbyshire Safe Place Scheme

## Details of the Scheme



### What is the Safe Place Scheme?

The Safe Places Scheme aims to help people feel safe when they are out and about. A Safe Place will display a Safe Place sticker on their window or door. Safe Places are places in Derbyshire people can go if they:

- feel ill
- are frightened
- have been threatened
- are lost



### How does the scheme work?

- Towns in Derbyshire have places where people can go for help. The places can be libraries, shops or council buildings.
- The staff in the Safe Places will be trained to help people.







### What is a Keep Safe Card?

A Keep Safe Card is a card for people to carry with them when they are out and about.

The card will have:

- The person's name
- The name of a family member or carer who can be contacted in an emergency
- Other important details.

	<h3>How does a Safe Place help people?</h3> <p>Staff can help people by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• calling a family member or carer to come and collect them</li> <li>• giving them somewhere safe to wait until help arrives</li> <li>• giving them practical help. (for example – giving them a glass of water if they feel sick)</li> <li>• being kind if they are upset</li> <li>• calling the police or an ambulance</li> </ul>
	<h3>How do I find a Safe Place?</h3> <p>There are Safe Places across the whole of Derbyshire including all Derbyshire libraries.
