Below are some easy to follow steps for accessing the online calculator.


Once you access the calculator there are also videos within the online form that you can watch to help you to complete each section.


2. Click on the purple "Visit the financial assessment" button.



3. When the Financial Assessment page has appeared, click on the purple "Log in to Continue" button.




You will then get a Log In screen.

4. You will be taken to the Financial Assessment Form page. Click on the purple "Start your assessment" button.

Financial Assessment Form (Adult Social Care)

Social care services, unlike health care, are not free for everyone over the age of 18. Most people will have to contribute something towards the cost of their care with some people having to pay the full cost.

Derbyshire County Council may cover some or all of the cost of your care in some circumstances, but help is "means-tested". This means that who pays depends on what your needs are, how much income and capital (including assets) you have, and what level and type of care and support you require.

You should complete this financial assessment form to determine:

- · whether you will need to contribute towards your care cost
- · whether you will have to meet the full costs yourself
- whether Derbyshire County Council will meet all the cost of your care

You will need information about your income, capital and expenses to complete this assessment form. See a full list here.

Please note: You will be asked to provide evidence of your income, capital and expenses after submitting your assessment form.

How to apply

- 5. Work through the pages providing the information required. Some questions must be answered to continue with the form. These are marked "required". You will need to provide information regarding the following:
 - People acting on your behalf
 - About you
 - People living with you
 - Your income and benefits
 - Your/Joint money or investments
 - Property/Land you own or rent
 - Sale or transfer of property, money or investments
 - Household Expenditure
 - Disability-Related Expenses

6. You will then be provided with an overview of the estimated charges for different types of care including Co-funding, respite care and residential care (see below)

First you will see the charges under the current policy:

Below is an example of how this could look

Non-residential (Co-Funding)

Based on the financial information you have provided, we estimate that the maximum weekly amount you will have to pay for your non-residential (co-funding) care will be £51.07. This will be confirmed following verification of the information you have provided.

Show breakdown

Respite

Based on the financial information you have provided, we estimate that the maximum weekly amount you will have to pay for your respite care will be £172.80. This will be confirmed following verification of the information you have provided.

Show breakdown

You can click on the 'Show breakdown' buttons which will display details of the calculation including income, expenses, Disability Related Expenses allowance and the Minimum Income Guarantee (titled Applicant Allowances Total).



You will also see what the the charges would be under the 3 options which are currently proposed.

Below is an example of how this could look

Non-residential (Co-Funding) option 1: 100% of disposable income

Based on the financial information you have provided, we estimate that the maximum weekly amount you would have to pay for your non-residential (co-funding) option 1 care would be £106.75.

Show breakdown

Non-residential (Co-Funding) option 2: 90% of disposable income

Based on the financial information you have provided, we estimate that the maximum weekly amount you would have to pay for your non-residential (co-funding) option 2 care would be £96.08.

Show breakdown

Non-residential (Co-Funding) option 3: 80% of disposable income

Based on the financial information you have provided, we estimate that the maximum weekly amount you would have to pay for your non-residential (co-funding) option 3 care would be £85.40.
